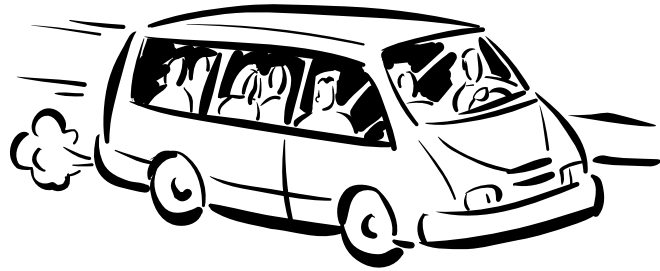

What is Shuttle U HOME?

- The *Shuttle U Home* program was established as a **FREE** means of transportation for SU/ESF students, faculty, and staff who reside off-campus.
- A six-passenger van is used to transport individuals from on-campus classes, academic programs, and co-curricular events to their off-campus residences within a designated geographic area.
- The program is operated by students working under the supervision of the Department of Public Safety.
- *Shuttle U Home* is available between the hours of 8:15 p.m. and 3:30 a.m., seven days a week, during the academic year.
- This program is not intended as a commercial means of transportation to and from retail establishments, nightclubs, or private places of employment.

How it Works

- Individuals are eligible for a ride if they are coming from an on-campus class, academic program, or co-curricular event, and are requesting a ride to their off campus residence within the program's designated geographic area.
- Individuals must first sign up in the Department of Public Safety Communications Center. Pick-up location is in front of the department, Sims Hall, 130 College Place.
- Individuals **must** show a valid SU/ESF I.D. to the shuttle monitor before entering the van.
- Transportation is provided for a maximum of six people at a time.
- Requests are serviced on a first come/first serve basis. *Please be patient while waiting for a ride.*
- Individuals must wear seat belts at all times while riding in the van.
- The Department of Public Safety reserves the right to deny a ride to anyone engaging in behavior that threatens the health, safety, or welfare of any person or persons.
- Shuttle service may be suspended during inclement weather.
- Shuttle service hours will be extended during final exam periods.

Prohibited – Non-students and persons not affiliated with SU; individuals who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or other drugs; eating, drinking, or smoking; transportation to any location other than home or locations outside of the designated geographic area; rude, loud, boisterous, or dangerous behavior.

Other Forms of Transportation

ON-CAMPUS LOCATIONS

- Walking escorts are available to SU/ESF students, faculty, and staff from any building or parking lot on North Campus to any other building or parking lot on North Campus.
- Student marshals provide the walking escort service during the hours of 5 p.m. and 3 a.m. throughout the academic year.
- At all other times, Public Safety Officers provide this service.
- To obtain a walking escort, call 443-2224.

This service does not extend to off-campus locations.

OFF-CAMPUS LOCATIONS

- Members of the University community are encouraged to use the CENTRO bus system whenever possible.
